Below are the minimal eligibility criteria for the potential student candidate:

Undergraduate students:

- Must have completed the first year of the bachelor's study.
- Be in Good Academic Standing.
- Be from one of the colleges mentioned above.
- Have a satisfactory TOEFL or IELTS report.
- Be a full-time student at AUK.

For alumni:

- Must have completed the bachelor's degree at AUK in one of the mentioned above departments.
- Have valid and satisfactory TOEFL or IELTS report.
