Program Description

The Transfer Student Program (TSP) is a 2+2 collaborative educational program between AUK and Wayne State University. This program allows AUK qualified Engineering students to continue their education at WSU having completed the first two years of education at AUK. Upon graduation from WSU, the students will qualify for a BSc degree awarded by WSU.

The hosting institution is offering a TSP program in the College of Engineering for the following disciplines:

- Mechanical Engineering
- Civil Engineering
- Electrical Engineering
- Chemical Engineering

Eligibility Criteria

Below are the minimal eligibility criteria for the potential student candidate:

- Must have achieved an overall high school average of 85% or higher and minimum of 80 in math and physics.
- Must have GPA of 3.20 or higher and have a B or better in Math and Physics.
- Must have completed the first 2 years of the bachelor's study at AUK.
- Be in Good Academic Standing (2.75 or higher GPA).
- Have a satisfactory TOEFL (79 and above) or IELTS report (6,5 and above).
- Be in the top quartile of the class during the first two years.
- Be a full-time student at AUK.

Costs

Tuition: Once the student is enrolled at WSU, the student will pay their tuition and fees to the host University. The total estimated expenses for two years to complete TSP at WSU is 98,334 USD, which includes tuition fees and cost of living on Campus.

Visa and Airfare: The student is responsible for the expenses of visa application and processing.

Application Process and Deadlines

Phase I:

- Upon meeting requirements for the first two years, students receive an official admission letter from WSU for F-1 visa application.
- Upon obtaining the F-1 visa, students enroll in WSU's College of Engineering.

Phase II:

- AUK-recommended students meeting WSU's admission standards proceed to Phase II.
- After Phase I completion and F-1 Visa approval, students transfer to WSU as undergraduates.
- Up to 60 credits from Phase I can be transferred to their undergraduate program at WSU.
- Upon completing 2 years (minimum 64 credit hours) of approved curricula and meeting degree requirements, students receive a WSU bachelor's degree.

If you would like to enroll by the next fall semester, please make sure to apply by March 1. The deadline for spring semester enrollment is October 1.
