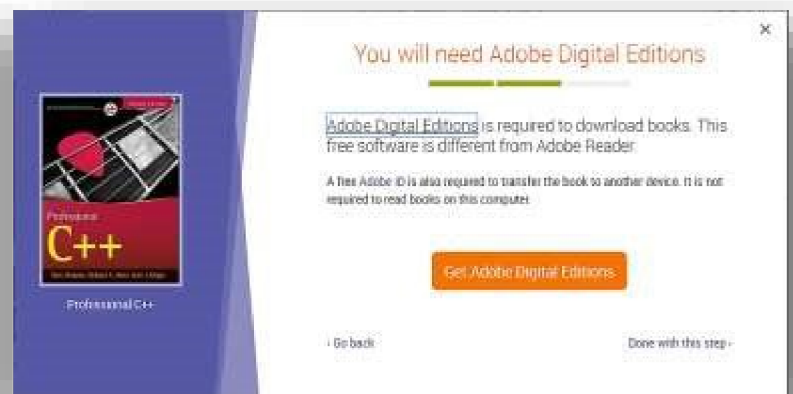
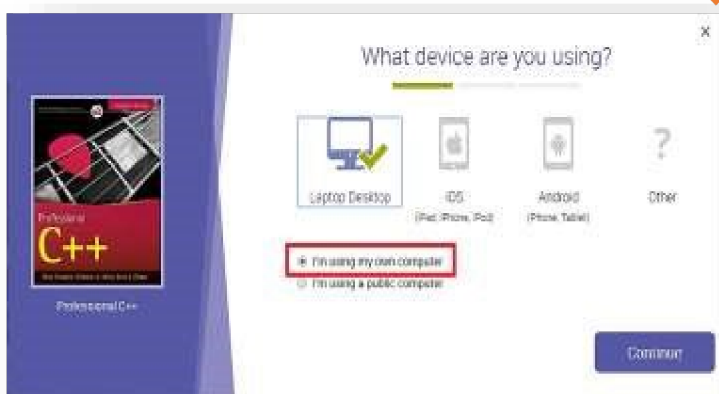


Print and Copy Limit Enhancement for ProQuest Ebook Central

- Default limits are 20% for copy and 40% for print/chapter download
- Reset rate of 24 hours

For example:

- Now, the patron can print 10% of the book today, leaving them 30% for the next 24 hours
- One day later, their limits reset and they can print 40% of the book again

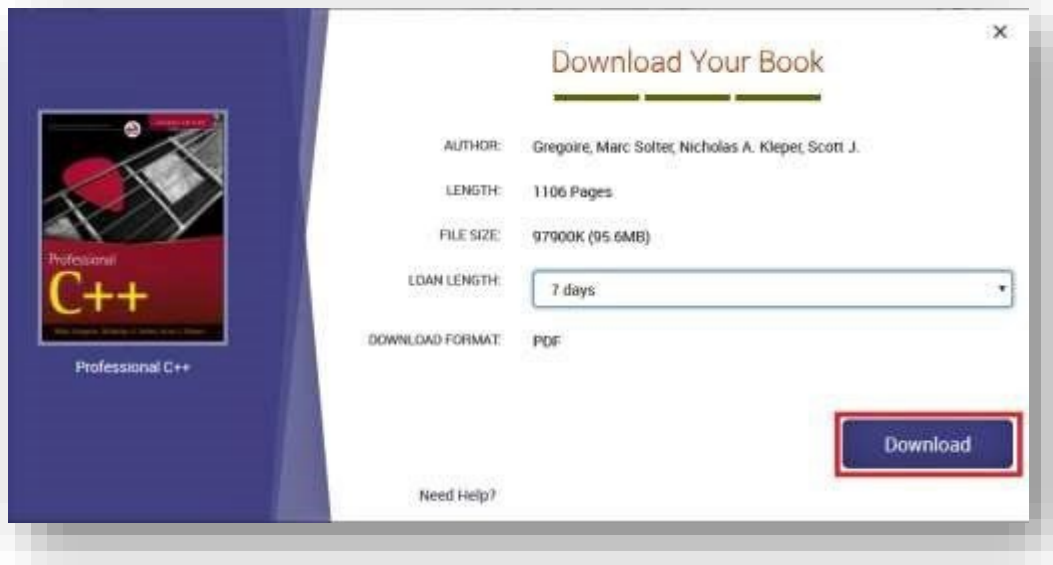


Step 1: Select device Editions

Step 2: Install Adobe Digital Editions

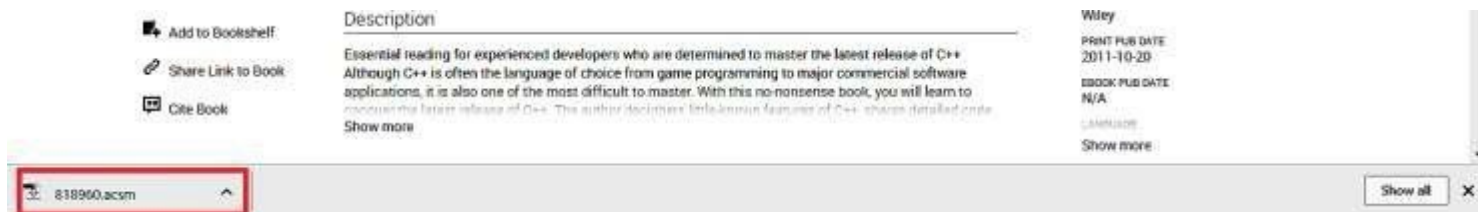
- To read the downloaded e -book, you need **Adobe Digital Editions (ADE)** software.
- AUK Students/Staff: Click on **Get Adobe Digital Editions** to Install ADE. And Click on **Done with this step** If you have already installed ADE software in your PC.

Downloaded e-books will be saved in your **Downloads** folder.

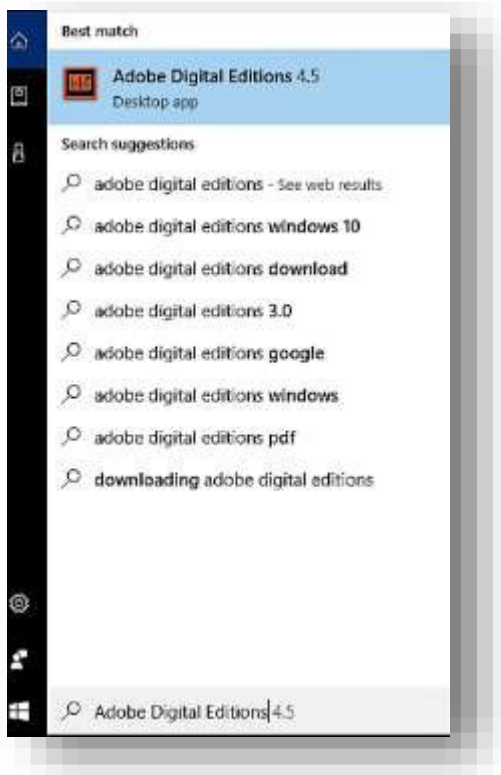



First time accessing Adobe Digital Editions (ADE)

The first time you open a downloaded e-book (which has an .acsm extension) with ADE, you will be asked to “Authorize Your Computer”.

- Check the box at the bottom left corner of screen: **“I want to Authorize my Computer without an ID”**, and click Next.
- **Do not** modify any default fields eg. eBook Vendor.

Authorize Your Computer

Authorizing your computer enables you to:

- Easily transfer Adobe DRM protected items between multiple computers and mobile devices.
- Read Adobe DRM-protected items on computers or mobile devices (up to six).

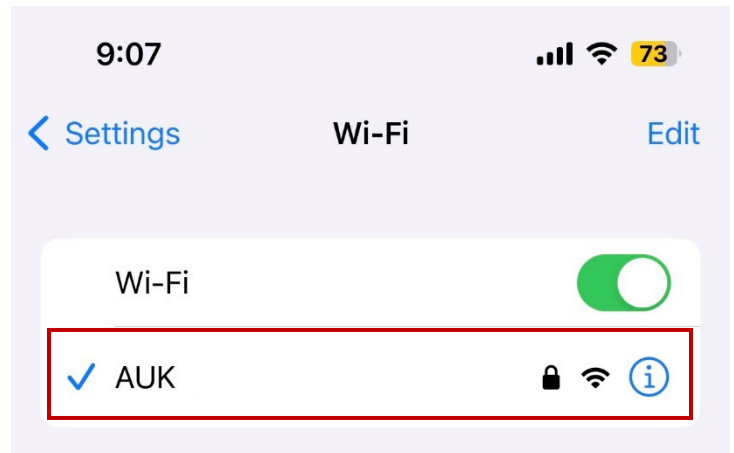
Downloading E-Books (Using Mobile Devices)

- ✓ Follow these Instructions to download e-books to your mobile device



1. Install **Bluefire Reader App** from Apple Store or Google Play Store

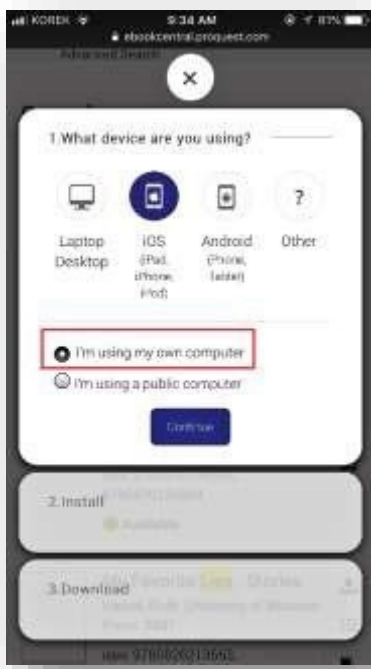
1. Ensure your mobile device is Connected to AUK-WIFI. This must be done on campus.



- At the e-book screen, select full download (if e-book is currently owned by AUK Library)



3. Select your Mobile device type

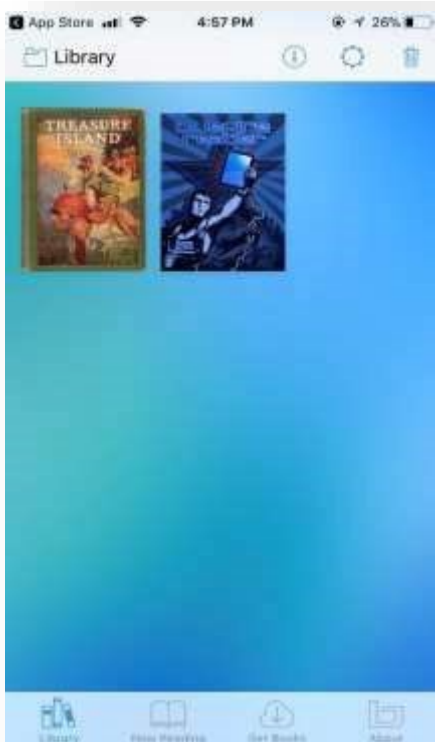
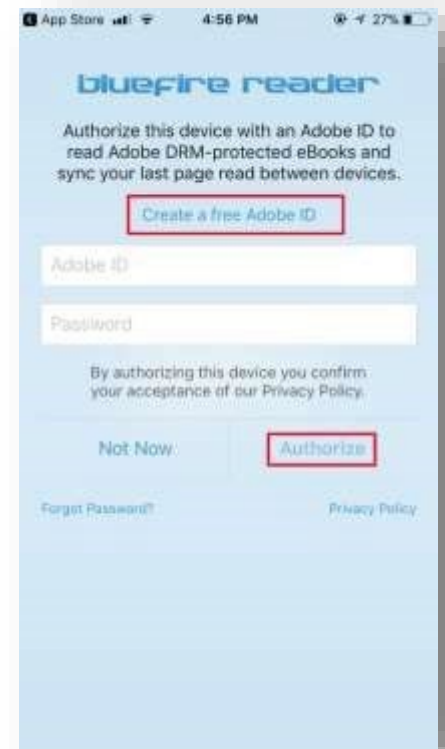


- Having already installed Bluefire Reader app, select **Done with this step.**
- Download the book.



Downloading E-Books (Using Mobile Devices)

6. Open the Downloaded e-book in Bluefire Reader app.
7. The first time you open Bluefire Reader, you are prompted to sign in your Adobe ID, and click Authorize. You can create a free Adobe ID if you do not have one.



8. E-book is now ready to be read in Bluefire Reader on your mobile device, both on and off campus.
